



"Shoot for Wooster" Tournament Rules

1. The team registration materials and roster must be filled out in its entirety.
2. Entry fee is \$125.00
3. Roster size is unlimited; however, 10 awards will be purchased and given to the tournament champions.
4. Registration fee deadline: Friday, December 1, 2009 or when tournament is at capacity (could be prior to December 1). Final roster may be submitted 1 hour prior to 1st game.
5. All players on a team must be from the same school district. (A school district may have several grade schools (i.e. Triway has 3 grade schools, Wooster has 8.) Players participating in the same recreational league are eligible to play on the same tournament team, as well.
6. *Each participant in this tournament shall be covered by his/her own family insurance coverage or the insurance of their own league.*
7. Participants must be in the 6th grade or under and may not have reached their 13th birthday prior to September 1, 2009 for the 6th grade tournament; 12th birthday prior to September 1, 2009 for the 5th grade tournament; or 11th birthday by September 1, 2009 for the 4th grade tournament. It is requested that the coach have a copy of each child's birth certificate at the tournament.
8. All games will be played at **Wooster High School, 515 Oldman Rd., Wooster, OH 44691.**
9. Coaches must turn in a team line-up 20 minutes before the scheduled game time.
10. Each team must have their own jerseys with numbers on the front and back.
11. Should two teams have the same jersey color, and the officials deem it necessary for one to change, a coin toss will determine the team to change. Vests will be available.
12. Each team will be required to supply an individual to assist the scorekeeper.
13. Team will be guaranteed three games.

14. Each game will consist of two 16 minute halves with a running clock. The clock will stop on every whistle the last 2 minutes of each half with 5 minutes between halves. The clock will also stop on foul shots.
15. Each team will have 3 time-outs per game. An additional time-out is granted for the overtime period and remaining time-outs from the game may not be used.
16. Any defense will be permitted.
17. **For the 4th grade tournaments**, there will be no full court press during the first 14 minutes of each half; defense must permit the offense to cross the mid-court line. In overtime periods, defenses may run a full court press.
For the 5th & 6th grade tournaments, full court press is permitted the entire game.
EXCEPTION: NO FULL COURT PRESS BY A TEAM THAT IS AHEAD BY 10 POINTS OR MORE.
18. **There will be a \$3 admission fee for adult spectators each day, and a \$2 fee for youth 2-17 each day. 2 coaches per team and players are admitted free.**
19. High school girl's size leather basketball will be used (28.5)
20. The 3 point line, regulation foul line (15 feet) and 10 foot baskets will be used. In the 4th grade division, the foul line will be 12'.
21. The overtime period will be 2 minutes in length with the clock stopping on each whistle. If the game is still tied at the end of overtime, all players (including bench players) on each team will line up at the foul line and take alternating foul shots until one player makes a foul shot. The team that scored the last points of the game or overtime will shoot last.
22. No protests will be permitted! The game officials and tournament director(s) will have final say on all matters.
23. Tournament director reserves the right to make adjustments in rules and format if unforeseen situations occur.
24. Ohio High School rules will apply except where listed in the preceding rules.
25. Food and beverages are **NOT** permitted in the facility. Gault Recreation staff will only allow **PLAIN WATER!**
26. Restroom facilities will be available for changing. (Showers not available.)
