

# Dayton Spring Classic COVID-19 Plan (Bales Arena, 27-28 Mar 21)

- Coaches, players, trainers, officials, and spectators will check their symptoms prior to departure for a game
- All coaches, players, trainers, officials, and spectators that exhibit any symptoms: fever, cough, loss of smell/taste, headache, nausea, vomiting, or other general sickness will not attend games
- Seats/benches are marked and spaced 6 ft apart. Those within the same family unit may sit together (4 max), otherwise the 6 ft of distance must be maintained.
- There is signage throughout the arena that shows masks are mandatory as well as social distancing (6 ft)
- We recommend that anybody 65 years of age or older, or who has underlying health conditions....not attend games
- The tournament director will contact all teams that played against any player that is reported to have tested positive for COVID-19 within 48 hours of the conclusion of the tournament. The player's local health department should also be contacted in cases of a positive test.
- Game times are staggered so that coaches, players, and spectators are not entering and exiting at the same time
- Masks are mandatory for everyone including coaches and players sitting on the bench. The only people approved of no masks are players playing in the game and officials. Note that officials and players are required to wear masks when entering and leaving the building.
- Social distancing is required. All spectators should maintain 6 ft of separation. Seats will be marked 6 ft apart.
- Hand sanitizer will be readily available at entrances and exits as well as at sites throughout the gym. Its use is heavily encouraged.
- Only 4 spectators/player allowed
- Scorekeepers are to sit on the end of their team's bench, not at the scorer's table. The only person at the scorer's table will be a clock operator.
- Disinfectant will be available on each scorer's table. Coaches will wipe down their team benches and score table upon arrival to the court. All shared and high touch surfaces (benches, equipment, rest rooms, etc) will be properly sanitized between events.

- Players are not to enter the building until 7 minutes prior to their scheduled game time.
- Spectators are not to enter the building until 3 minutes prior to scheduled game time
- Spectators and coaches are not to watch/scout other opponents, or watch other teams from their organization, or watch other childhood friends play.
- As soon as the game is over, spectators, coaches, and players should immediately leave the building. No team meetings or huddles inside the building.
- No handshakes between the teams.
- Players are not to share any personal equipment (water bottles, towels, etc)
- Water fountains have been turned off.
- Spectators will be limited to 15% capacity or 300 total (the lesser number)
- Anybody not following these rules is subject to removal from the gym. Refusal to leave will result in the associated team's forfeit of the game.
- The compliance officer will be Brett Bush, SBA Sports, Vice-President.
